Humanities and Social Science Campus in Seoul



Seoul Campus is located near the economic, political and cultural center of downtown Seoul. It has easy access to public transportations and is close to Sinchon area, one of the favorite haunts of university students.

Academic Support: Global BUDDY

Global BUDDY students, who have high academic standing, are dedicated to providing academic support to international students. Assigned BUDDY and international student(s) meet every week, and international students receive assistance with their assignments, especially those with which they find difficulty due to lack of proficiency in Korean language.



International Exchange Program

Exchange Program

International exchange student, nominated by Myongji University's partner institution, studies at Myongji for one semester or one academic year.

During their Study at Myongji, International Exchange Students are:

- Myongji University tuition waived
- Provided with academic and administrative support from International Outreach Student Club (OULAMI) and academic advisors throughout their stay in Korea
- Able to choose from any undergraduate courses taught in Korean or English for credit earning (course registration depends on student's level of Korean or English proficiency)
- Able to participate in various cultural activities with Korean students
- Able to improve their Korean language by taking free Korean tutoring sessions organized by Korean peers
- Eligible to register for intensive Korean language courses offered at the Korean Language Education Center (KLEC) with scholarship benefits
- Take part in "Language Exchange Program" by teaching their native language in return for learning Korean
- Obtain official academic transcript at the end of their exchange program
- Continue to experience Korean culture by taking part in summer/winter program (special scholarship provided to exchange students)



Visiting Program

Students studying in Myongji University as visiting students share the same benefits as exchange students, but they are required to pay tuition and fees to Myongji University during their enrollment.



Short-term programs [Summer/Winter at Myongji]

Summer/Winter at Myongji is a program designed for international students to experience Korean culture as they participate in various activities and excursions with Korean students. Programs include Korean language education, visits to famous tourist sites in Seoul, hands-on craft-making activities, and etc.

Undergraduate Admission

Admission for Undergraduate Programs

Requirements

For both new students and transfer students

- Applicant and both parents must be non-Korean
- Either graduated or should be expected to graduate from high school
- Language Proficiency: Applicants must meet one of the following conditions :
 - ① Obtained an TOPIK level 3 or above
 - ② Passed Korean Language Test at Myongji University
 - ③ Enrolled and completed level 3 Korean language course through university or college in Korea

Transfer [2nd year] students

- Students who have completed one academic year and earned corresponding academic credits at another 4-year university
- Students who have graduated or who are expected to be graduate from a 2-year college/university in China

Transfer [3rd year] students

- Students who have completed two academic years and earned corresponding academic credits at another 4-year university
- Students who have graduated or who are expected to be graduate from 2~3 year college [3-year college/university or above in China]

Application Period

- Spring Semester [starting in March] : October~December
- Fall Semester [starting in September] : April~June

Scholarship and Supplementary living allowance

First semester for new students and Transfer students

- ➔ Students without TOPIK Level 3: Eligible to receive 20% of tuition fee (as supplementary living allowance)
- ➔ Students with TOPIK of level 3: Eligible to receive 40% of tuition fee (as scholarship)
- ➔ Students with TOPIK of level 4: Eligible to receive 60% of tuition fee (40% as scholarship, 20% as supplementary living allowance)
- ➔ Students with TOPIK of level 5: Eligible to receive 70% of tuition fee (40% as scholarship, 30% as supplementary living allowance)
- ➔ Students with TOPIK of level 6: Eligible to receive 80% of tuition fee (40% as scholarship, 40% as supplementary living allowance)

※ Living expense will be provided after the semester starts

※ Scholarships and living expenses above are only provided when TOPIK is obtained before First semester starts

Admissions from Myongji University: Students who have enrolled from Myongji's Korean Language Education Center(KLEC) or an exchange/visiting student for more than one semester will receive ₩400,000 of living expense

※ Supplementary living allowance will be provided after the semester starts

Enrolled student: From second semester, scholarship and supplementary living allowance will be provided according to the GPA of previous semester

- ➔ Students with GPA of 4.0[A] or above, altogether with TOPIK Level 4 (TOPIK Level 3 in case of College of Arts & Physical Education students) : waiver of tuition fees
 - ➔ Students with GPA of 3.5[B+] or above, altogether with TOPIK Level 4 (TOPIK Level 3 in case of College of Arts & Physical Education students) : about 50% exemption from tuition fee
 - ➔ Students with GPA of 3.0[B] or above: about 40% exemption from tuition fee
 - ➔ Students with GPA of 2.5[C+] or above: about 20% exemption from tuition fee
- ※ Student must obtain more than 12 credit for each semester

TOPIK scholarship for Enrolled student

₩300,000 Supplementary living allowance will be presented to students who obtain TOPIK Level 4 or higher (Students who had obtained TOPIK Level 4 or higher before the entrance cannot receive the scholarship again)

Dormitory

The Dormitory Building in Seoul Campus was built in 2006, a 9-story building with a capacity of 864 students with 309 rooms. There are five Dormitory Buildings in Yongin Campus which can host 1,866 students.
