Program Arrangement in Detail

Schedule:

Classes Arrangements:

Each student will be assigned to appropriate classes based on student's proficiency in Chinese. Jiaxing University may arrange placement test to evaluate students' Chinese Proficiency.

Introduction of Some Faculty Members



Zhang Shan, with master's degree, whose research direction is teaching Chinese as a foreign language, has been awarded the Certificate for Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages and Certificate of Honor for Government-sponsored Faculty Exchange. From 2013 to 2015, she had taught Chinese in Far Eastern Federal University in Russia as a Chinese teacher sponsored by Confucius Institute. She is mainly responsible for the teaching of Oral Chinese, Chinese Listening, and Comprehensive Chinese and so on.

Ma Lin, Doctor of Literature, obtained Certificate of Accreditation in Teaching Chinese as a Foreign Language in 2003 and has rich teaching experience. She is deputy secretary of Jiaxing Writers' Association. She was awarded as an excellent instructor of Zhejiang Provincial Chinese Classics Reading Contest and published prose anthology named *Love Is So Short While Forgetting Is So Long*. She also translated Confessions into Chinese.
