

Package A Stomatology

- 1. To learn the basic theory and knowledge of stomatology, including the science of diagnosis, treatment, prevention and other aspects of oral and maxillofacial diseases;
- To master the basic ability to diagnose, repair, as well as prevent and care common oral diseases and frequently-occurring diseases.







Package B Metabolomics

- 1. To meet with the leading metabolomics research team in CQMU;
- 2. To visit the metabolomics lab, learn lab safety, and understand metabolomic theory and instrument operation.;
- 3. To learn microfluidic technology and make your own microfluidic chip.







Package C Paediatrics

- 1. To visit the Children's hospital / College of Paediatric(top-3 in China) and the Scientific Research Platform;
- 2. To visit the National Children's Regional Medical Center and the National Clinical Medical Research Center;
- 3. To attend lectures from our leading paediatrics professor.







Package D Orthopedics & Rehabilitation

- 1. To learn about Cervical Spondylosis treatment (Problem-Based Learning) and Minimal Access Surgery;
- 2. To observe smart healthcare practice and the department of orthopedics;
- 3. To learn Chinese traditional medical healthcare and rehabilitation, such as acupuncture.
- 4. To visit the Second Affiliated Hospital of CQMU, including its history, heritage and development.







Package E Traditional Chinese Medicine

- 1. To recognize common medicinal plants, learn the traditional identification experience and the modern identification methods of crude drugs, research and explore theoretical and practical issues such as authenticity identification of crude drugs;
- 2. To learn the four diagnosis of diseases in traditional Chinese medicine, such as watching, listening, question and feeling the pulse;
- 3. To learn and experience the non-pharmacological acupuncture and cupping.





Notes for Program Fee



- Regarding the partner relationship between our universities, CQMU is willing to sponsor 5 participants the program fee (including instructional cost, local transportation, admission fee for cultural spots and accommodations, except for the cost of round-trip travel, visas, meals and other personal expenses).
- The proposed program fee is for reference only. The final amount will be charged according to the actual expenses.
